7. Termination

Either party may terminate this Contract immediately with a written notice if the other party fails to perform its obligations under the Contract. In the event of termination, the Client shall pay the Contractor for work completed up to the date of termination.

8. Warranty

The Contractor warrants that all materials used and work performed will be free from defects for a period of ______ from the completion date. Any defects discovered within this period will be promptly corrected at no additional cost to the Client. Client error and wear and tear due to normal use are excluded from the scope of this provision.

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
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
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
